

The victim, who nearly of heroin and opiate abuse and addiction has become one of the most significant concerns and threats to families and our community. Sergeant Parkinson consistently demonstrates tremendous dedication to narcotics detection and apprehension, knowing that drug abuse and addiction are the main drivers of property and violent crimes, heartbreak and often death.

In March 2015, Sergeant Parkinson and his squad were summoned to a physical domestic. He identified the presence of drug paraphernalia, and obtained a search warrant, which ultimately resulted in a large drug seizure and subsequent forfeiture of \$8.9K in suspected drug funds.

Additionally, Sergeant Parkinson is a strong proponent of education, and represents the Department on the Narcotics

tion Task Force (NOPE), to educate school students and staff in an effort to save young

As a result of his outstanding investigative skills, Sergeant Parkinson was temporarily assigned to the Department's **Criminal Investigation Division** in the Fall of 2015 to assist in the investigation of a proliferation of serious crimes that impacted the township in the latter half of 2015.



The 2016 budget was adopted with a .15 mil general fund tax increase focusing primarily on police services, and a new .5 mil tax towards a new fire service fund to improve fire and rescue efforts. The increase equates to an additional \$82/yr to the average household.
