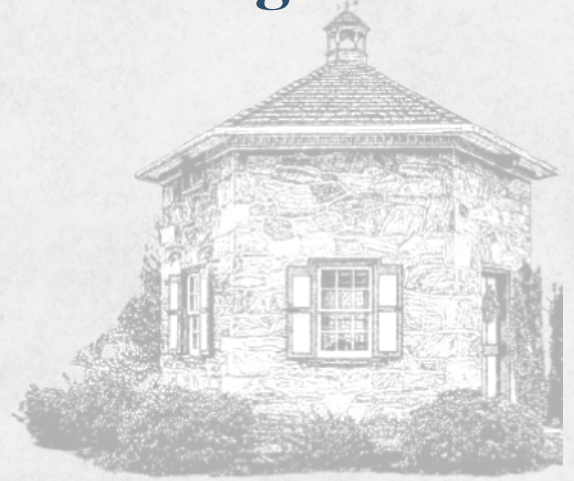

# Upcoming Developments

## 3205 Lincoln Highway (Former Kmart building)

- Phase 2 (Pad Sites) - Land Development Plan submitted, reviewed, and awaiting response.
- Phase 1 (existing building) -Grading and stormwater permit approved.
- Conditional Use application approved in November 2021.

## All-Fill, Inc. (4060 & 4102 Edges Mill Rd)

- Conditional Use Application submitted and under review
- Discussed at the Planning Commission meeting on October 19, 2021.
- Applicant submitted a sketch plan for review by the Township Engineer and the Planning Commission. The plan proposes to consolidate tax parcels 39-1-114 and 39-1-114.1, construct a new shared driveway entrance off of Edges Mill Road, and to construct a new 41,000 sq ft flex building with parking in the front and loading areas in the rear.

# Fall Chipping Program

The Township will continue to offer its scheduled chipping program for large branches. This service is only intended for cleaning up fallen branches in your yard and not for items cut down by a contractor. To sign up for a chipping slot, please call 610-384-0600 x140 between September 1st and September 30th.

## CHIPPING PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- All branches must be neatly stacked curbside (no cross stacking), no larger than 6" in diameter and with cut ends facing the street by 6:00 AM the day of your appointment (recommended the night before). Road crews will not drive onto property or private lanes/road ways, nor will road crews go beyond the edge of the property to collect the branches.
- Appointments will be limited to 15 minutes with NO EXCEPTIONS.
- No stumps. Branches greater than 6" in diameter will NOT be accepted.
- Vines, weeds, leaves, or yard waste will NOT be collected.
- Incorrectly stacked piles will NOT BE PICKED UP.
- Late set outs or oversized piles will NOT be accepted.
- The program is for routine clean-up and not designed to assist with clearing properties of trees and shrubs (i.e. no cutting trees down and putting them out for chipping).
- This program is for individual Caln Township residential properties only. A resident may use this service one time during the program period.

Wood chips are composted along with leaves vacuumed up later in the fall. The resulting compost is available free to township residents behind the police station.

## Senior Resident Program



The Caln Township Police Department would like to remind you about our Senior Resident Program, it is another example of how the department is dedicated to policing with our community. This program has been very successful for many years, and we have many privileged citizens that enjoy the added peace of mind knowing that the Police Department is watching out for them. Members call the police station daily and a volunteer on the weekend to let us know that all is well. This program is

### Peddler's/Solicitor's License and ID cards:

Every person/business wishing to peddle or solicit within the border of Caln Township shall first apply to the Caln Township Police Department for a Peddler's/Solicitor's license and identity card pursuant to a background check. Therefore, no person shall engage in peddling or soliciting or use the public ways without first having received an approved Peddling/Soliciting license and ID card from the Caln Township Police Department. The license and ID card shall be displayed by any individual performing the function of peddler/solicitor upon request of any police officer or resident of the premises being visited.

Please Note: All peddler/solicitor licenses and ID cards will display a start date and an expiration date on the card and all ID cards will be posted on our Facebook page.



Please share this reminder with your friends and neighbors! Many residents think they're being helpful by bagging their recycling, but those pesky plastic bags actually gum up the works at our recycling facilities, decreasing efficiency and increasing costs. Only plastics marked #1-7 belong in your recycle cart! Reusable bags are a better option, but if you end up with plastic bags and films, they can be recycled in the designated bin at grocery store entrances. Thank you for recycling!
