## Municipal Drive Bridge Replacement

- Currently installing pilings, walers and shoring sheets.
- Demolition of the old bridge has been completed.
- All utilities have been moved from the construction area.
- Crews bypassed the bridge area and re-graded the stream.
- Anticipated completion by 7/17/2023.
