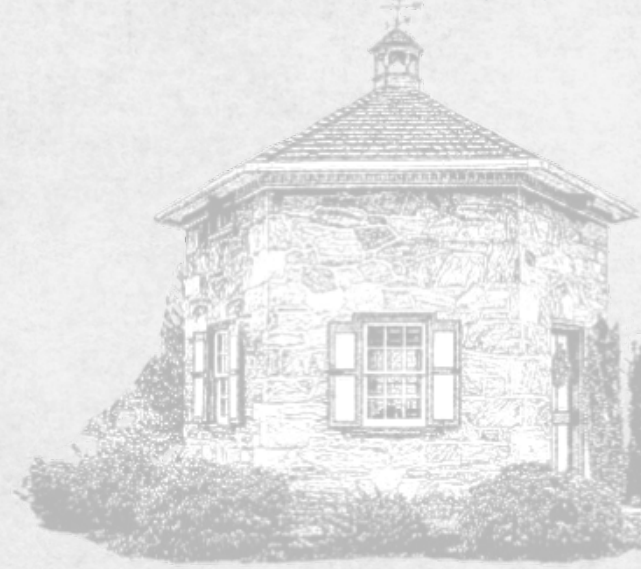

- 50 Rock Raymond Rd. (Taco Bell) - approved for development, finalizing legal agreements, request for extension of zoning variance approval, ZHB approved extension. Resubmission received and in review.

- Behrle/The Villages at Hillview - preliminary plan approved conditioned on outstanding review letters.

- Christian Faith Fellowship - motion for approval of preliminary plan approval being prepared for the Board of Commissioners.

- Hills at Thorndale Woods - final PRD plan resubmission in review.

- Wild Meadows – Board of Commissioners approved scheduling a hearing for the matter on November 12 at 7:00PM at the Thorndale Fire Hall.

- 2131 Lincoln Highway – Zoning change to allow self storage facilities by conditional use in the C-1 Highway Commercial District. Board of Commissioners voted to approve the text amendment.
