Upcoming Developments

3205 Lincoln Highway (Former Kmart building)

- On Planning Commission agenda for October 18.
- Phase 2 (Pad Sites) -Land Development Plan submitted, reviewed, and awaiting response.
- Phase 1 (existing building) -Grading and stormwater permit approved.
- Conditional Use application approved in November 2021.

- Conditional Use
 Hearing scheduled for
 October 27 @ 6:00 PM.
- Land Development Plan submitted and under review. Scheduled for Planning Commission meeting on October 18.
- Applicant submitted a sketch plan for review by the Township Engineer and the Planning Commission. The plan proposes to consolidate tax parcels 39-1-114 and 39-1-114.1, construct a new shared driveway entrance off of Edges Mill Road, and to construct a new 41,000 sq ft flex building with parking in the front and loading areas in the rear.

Leaf Vacuuming

- Leaf vacuuming will begin the week of October 24. Rather than bagging your leaves, you need only rake them to the front of your property, immediately adjacent to the road's edge. Leaves must be as close to the road's edge as possible and not obstructed by vehicles. Please DO NOT rake leaves into the street as leaves could get washed into storm inlets during inclement weather or can freeze to the roadway as we get cooler temperatures.
- Below is the schedule for this season's leaf pickup:
 - Township leaf vacuuming begins "week" of the following dates
 - Week of October 24th and Week of November
 7th for the Monday and Tuesday Trash
 Customers.
 - Week of October 31st and Week of November 14th for the Wednesday and Thursday Trash Customers.
 - Week of November 28th and Week of December
 5th (Township Wide Clean Up)

There is no appointment necessary for this service

Leaf Bag Collection

In addition to leaf vacuuming, A.J. Blosenski will again be collecting leaves that are placed at the curb in biodegradable bags as part of the bi-weekly Yard Waste Collection Program.

- Remember leaves that are placed in bags that are NOT biodegradable bags will not be collected.
- PLEASE HAVE BAGS OUT AT THE CURB NO LATER THAN 5:00 AM on your yard waste collection day

- Address concerns about the school-to-prison pipeline;
- Prevent substance abuse and promote a healthy lifestyle;
- Discuss the question of "what if..." which haunts many individuals whose bad decisions led to jail.
