## LEAF COLLECTION

Leaf collection will begin the week of October 19, 2009 with bag pickup. Leaf bags are available for purchase at the Caln Township building. Bags come in bundles of 3 for \$1.00 but can also be purchased individually at \$.35 each. Besides leaf bag pickup, the Township will again be vacuuming. Rather than bagging your leaves, you need to only rake them to the front of your property immediately adjacent to the road's edge. **LEAVES MUST BE AS CLOSE TO THE ROAD'S EDGE AS POSSIBLE.**

**PLEASE DO NOT RAKE LEAVES INTO THE STREET** as leaves could get washed into storm inlets during inclement weather or can freeze to the roadway as we get cooler temperatures.



## FROM THE HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT...

### Tree Trimming along Road Right-of-ways

The Township Road Department will be cutting back overhanging branches, brush, and vegetation from the roadways as required to maintain clear and passable roadways throughout the Township. Overhanging trees obstruct the roadway when they are weighted down by snow, creating difficult situations for our snow removal vehicles. Please check the road frontage of your property to see if your trees or shrubs may be overhanging the road or obstructing street signs.


If you prefer to prune back your own trees or shrubs, please use the following as a guide:

- 1) Tree branches and bushes should be clear of the road edge by a minimum of (24") two feet and that clearance should extend to (10') ten feet in height.
- 2) New plantings, i.e. trees, shrubs, etc. should not be planted within the road right-of-way! Please contact the Township Zoning Office for these specifications prior to planting to avoid excess work.

\*Trees and shrubs don't stay small - they only get larger.

## FROM THE CODES DEPARTMENT...

### HOME IMPROVEMENT CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT 132

A message from the Pennsylvania Attorney General, Tom Corbett:  
What is the Home Improvement Consumer Protection Act?

"Dear Fellow Pennsylvanians:

If you are a homeowner, you will be pleased to know about the Home Improvement Consumer Protection Act. The law affords protection for consumers who hire contractors for home remodeling projects.

Effective July 1, 2009, contractors who perform home improvements totaling \$5,000 or more per year must register with the Office of the Attorney General. The law requires written contracts between the contractor and consumer when the price of the project exceeds \$500, and for criminal penalties for violations of the act. If you are remodeling your home, be sure your contractor is registered with the Office of Attorney General before you sign a contract.

What is home improvement fraud? Home Improvement fraud occurs when-

- A contractor intentionally provides false or misleading information to convince a consumer to enter into an agreement for home improvements.
- A contractor receives payment and fails to provide the services or materials.
- A contractor damages a person's property in order to solicit an agreement for services or materials.
- A contractor alters a contract or other documents without the consent of the consumer.
- A contractor publishes false or deceptive advertisements.
- A contractor misrepresents material as special order material or misrepresents the cost of special order material.
- A contractor represents himself or herself as an employee of a governmental unit or public utility.

What are my rights?

- A home improvement contractor must provide you with a copy of the complete contract free of charge.
- You have the right to rescind your home improvement contract without penalty within three business days of the signing date, except as provided under law for emergency situations.
- A home improvement contract is not enforceable against a consumer if it does not include all of the information required by law.
- A contractor may not demand or receive any payment for a home improvement before the home improvement contract is signed.

Where can I find my contractor's registration number?

- All contractors must display their official registration number on all contracts, estimates, proposals, and advertisements distributed within the Commonwealth.

## Attention Public Sewer Customer Reminder

Now that the weather will be getting nice, property owners are reminded to inspect their own plumbing in order to identify illegal hookups and to remove any illegal connections to the public sewer system. For example, sump pump connections, floor drains, improper heights of sewer vent stacks and clean outs located in your yard may be allowing surface water to run into the sewer system illegally. Illegal connections create an artificially high cost for sewer treatment. Currently the Township and Municipal Authority are doing all they can to stabilize and reduce high treatment costs by implementing a strict inflow and infiltration program to help stabilize and reduce these costs. Property owners can help reduce the amount of inflow and infiltration into the sanitary sewer by disconnecting illegal connections. Sump pumps which are harmlessly discharging outside onto the ground are not illegal and do not need attention.

Property owners should be aware that homes with illegal connections detected through other means (i.e.: dye testing, camera inspection) may ultimately be cited for being in violation of Resolution 2005-1-CTMA subsection 12A. This prohibits discharge of "any storm water, surface water, ground water, water from sump pumps or floor drains, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, cooling water or unpolluted industrial process waters." Penalties may be incurred as noted in Resolution 2005-1-CTMA subsection 35 which states, "violators may be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than \$1000 for each offense plus costs and attorney fees. Each separate building, each separate dwelling and each separate discharge in respect to which a violation occurs shall be deemed a separate offense."

#### Other ways to reduce mail-

When you buy a new product, don't fill out the warranty card. They are solely a means of gathering names for direct-mail lists. You are covered by the manufacturer's warranty whether the card is returned or not.

When you order personal checks, consider leaving off your telephone number. Companies sell lists gleaned from the name and numbers on customer's checks.

Request that credit card, mail order companies and magazines you subscribe to not sell your name to other companies. Don't give companies your telephone number to enter into their computer/cash register when you make a purchase. If you give them your phone number, more than likely you'll be added to their mailing list.







The Chipping Program was designed to assist residents, free of charge, with removal of downed tree limbs and branches. Requests for the Fall 2009 Chipping Program can be made starting Wednesday, September 9, 2009. Appointments are required. The first available appointment for the Fall 2009 Chipping Program is Tuesday, September 15, 2009. The program will run weekly Tuesdays and Thursdays through November 5, 2009. Appointments will be taken through Friday, October 9, 2009.

**IN AN EFFORT TO ACCOMMODATE ALL REQUESTS FOR APPOINTMENTS, WE REQUEST THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES BE STRONGLY ADHERED TO:**

- All branches and limbs must be stacked at the front of the property next to the street (where trash cans are placed for pickup).  
Note: Due to liability concerns, the road crews will not drive onto property or private lanes/road ways, nor will road crews go beyond the edge of the property to collect the limbs.
- All branches should face the same direction (no cross-stacking) with the blunt/cut end facing the street
- No stumps or limbs greater than 8" in diameter
- A resident may use this free service one time during the program period
- No vines, weeds, leaves, or yard waste will be collected
- **THE PROGRAM IS FOR ROUTINE CLEANUP AND NOT DESIGNED TO ASSIST WITH CLEARING PROPERTIES OF TREES AND SHRUBS (I.E. CUTTING TREES DOWN AND PUTTING OUT FOR CHIPPING WILL NOT BE CHIPPED).**
- This program is for individual Caln Township residential properties only. Items collected from outside the Township or through a private or commercial operation will not be processed.
