STREET RESTORATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Application must be made for all street openings, pole erections and removals. Applications are available at the Township office.
2. No permit to open or break the surface of any street or alley shall be issued between December 1st and March 1st except in the case of an emergency.
3. Openings on state highways--the applicant must apply for a permit with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
4. Applicant must notify the police and fire departments prior to any openings of streets.
5. Barricades are to be placed to protect all vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Warning signs must be posted. A flagman must be provided to direct traffic where required.
6. If street is to be left open all night, a sufficient number of warning blinkers and flares must be provided and prominently displayed.
7. All underground facilities must be protected. The applicant is responsible for all damages that are incurred. To locate underground facilities before digging call 1-800-242-1776.
8. The use of dynamite and other explosives are prohibited.
9. No attachments or openings are to be made on any bridges or culverts.
10. Mats or protective pads must be used to protect the pavements from the steel traveling pads of equipment. Damages to the pavements or curbs will be the responsibility of the applicant.
11. If street is opened over half its width, applicant must make a temporary restoration as soon as backfilling is completed. The permanent restoration shall be made in two stages, keeping the street open half its width at all times.
12. All trenches to be cut back 12" on all sides to support newly installed base material.
13. Backfill material shall be of 2A Modified sub-base mechanically tamped in 12" layers followed by 4" BCBC and 2" ID2 Wearing Course, all mechanically tamped.
14. Applicant is responsible for backfill for a period of one year after date that permanent restoration is made.
15. All road/street openings to be sealed upon completion with type "BM" oil or equivalent.
16. Caln Township reserves the right to revoke the permit for any violations of the above.
