Dear Abbey Swan,

I am writing to submit a request under the Pennsylvania Right to Know Law. If you are not the Open Records Officer for Caln Township, please forward this request to the appropriate person.

I request records showing which employee jobs classifications / titles / positions are not represented by a union, and how many employees are in each classification. As an example of the type of information I am looking for, if transportation staff are not represented by a union, I would be interested in knowing their job titles and number of employees, such as “Bus Drivers (15 Employees). Bus Aides (5 Employees).”

If the agency does not already maintain that list or combination of lists, then I request the following:

- Records showing the number of employees in each job classification / title / position, such as payroll records or an employee directory (feel free to redact all extraneous information).
- Records showing which classifications are represented by a union, such as collective bargaining agreements, and which are not represented by a union.

Again, I am only interested in the employee job classifications not represented by a union and how many employees are in each classification. If primary records specifically showing that information do not currently exist, it may be easier for the agency to prepare a spreadsheet or email with that information rather than provide these other records. Of course, there is no obligation for the agency to prepare such a record, so if one doesn't exist, these alternative documents would allow me to recreate that list.

Please provide all responsive records and responses to this request by email. Please provide them in a searchable, manipulable electronic format, such as an Excel spreadsheet or a CSV file, to the extent these records are maintained or easily retrieved from a database in that format. Please advise if there will be any costs associated with this request before those costs are incurred.

Please let me know if you have any questions or require any clarification. I understand that extensions may be required due to current circumstances, so please let me know if the agency requires more time to respond to this request.
