The Caln Clean Up Crew is back at it again! Join us for targeted monthly litter clean ups of areas that are harder to reach. Flaggers will be on hand, but due to traffic, these clean ups would be best suited for adults.

New this year: The Caln Clean Up Crew is excited to announce a new recognition program for repeat volunteers! Starting this year, volunteers will receive Clean Up Crew rewards for participating in multiple clean up efforts!



Our April 6/7 Community Clean Up Weekend volunteers blew us away! Over two days, 121 people collected 185 bags of trash (plus 14 tires, and a lot of random larger objects), filling three truck beds. They cleaned miles of roads and streams, and even managed to recover a lost wallet! A special thank you to Midway Grill for sponsoring this event! What an amazing group effort!



The Township will continue to offer its scheduled chipping program for branches beginning on May 6th. This service is only intended for cleaning up fallen branches in your yard and not for items cut down by a contractor. To sign up for our chipping list, please call 610-384-0600 x140 by April 30th.

- All branches must be neatly stacked curbside (no cross stacking), no larger than 6" in diameter and with cut ends facing the street by May 6th in the morning.
- Road crews will not drive onto property or private lanes/road ways, nor will road crews go beyond the edge of the property to collect the branches.
- Crews will chip branches for up to 15 minutes per address.
- Vines, stumps, weeds, leaves, and yard waste will NOT be collected.
- Incorrectly stacked piles will NOT BE PICKED UP.
- NO LATE SET OUTS OR OVERSIZED PILES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- THE PROGRAM IS FOR ROUTINE CLEAN-UP AND NOT DESIGNED TO ASSIST WITH CLEARING PROPERTIES OF TREES AND SHRUBS.
