

2020 Census Update



Census takers have started visiting homes that haven't yet responded to the 2020 Census. Census takers will wear masks and follow local public health guidelines when they visit your home. All census takers complete

a virtual COVID-19 training on social distancing and other health and safety protocols before beginning their work in neighborhoods. If no one is home when the census taker visits, the census taker will leave a notice of their visit with information about how to respond online, by phone or by mail.

How Can You Verify That Someone Is a Census Taker?

If someone visits your home this year to collect information for the 2020 Census, check to make sure they have a valid ID badge with their photograph, a U.S. Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date. Census workers may also carry Census Bureau bags and other equipment with the Census Bureau logo.

You can also still respond to the census online at my2020census.gov.

The last day to request a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot is October 27th, but we recommend getting your request in ASAP.

The last day for County Boards of Elections to receive mail-in and absentee ballots is November 3rd (must be received by 8:00 P.M.).

You must be registered to vote to request a mail-in or absentee ballot. To check your voter registration or to

Historical Commission News

A new roof has just been installed on Caln's Hexagonal schoolhouse, helping to ensure the beauty and safety of this irreplaceable gem. The Schoolhouse also recently received a fresh coat of paint, and is a welcoming site along G.O. Carlson Blvd. We are hoping that monthly tours (currently on hold due to COVID-19 safety concerns) will be able to resume in the coming months. The Schoolhouse was moved from Edge Lane to the Township building in 1968 in honor of the Township's Centennial. It's even featured on the Township logo! COVID-19 Contact Tracing

- If you've been in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19, you may be contacted by a contact tracer or public health worker from the PA or Chester County health department in an effort to help slow the spread of the disease.
- All information you share with a contact tracer, like who you've been in contact with and your recent whereabouts, is confidential.
- Be aware of scammers pretending to be COVID-19 contact tracers. Legitimate contact tracers will never ask for your Social Security Number, Medicare Number, or financial/payment information. If someone calls and asks for personal information, hang up and report it to the police at 610-383-1821.

Upcoming Development Update

- Willows at Valley Run (2131 Lincoln Hwy.) Seeking conditional use approval for a 120 unit apartment complex with community building. Received Planning Commission recommendation for approval with conditions. Scheduled for conditional use hearing on August 27.
- The owners of Chester County Sports Arena have submitted a conditional use/land development application for recreational use at the current Bob Wagner's property. Attended Conditional Use Hearing on August 13, 2020. Working on addressing review comments from the BoC.
- 50 Rock Raymond Rd. (Taco Bell) Requesting modification of conditional use to add second drive-through lane. Conditional use hearing occurred on July 30th, no decision yet.
- AGC Chemical - Land development for building expansion approved. Resubmission was discussed at August Planning Commission meeting. PC recommended approval pending conditions.
