2020 CENSUS

The U.S. Census is the basis for distribution of federal and state funding, political representation, and community decision making. An accurate census will ensure that county residents receive their fair share of federal funding. Since the last U.S. Census in 2010, it is estimated that the population of Chester County has grown by 5% or over 23,000 people.

- By April 1 (Census Day) each household will receive an invitation for you to complete the census online. If you haven't responded by April 16th, you will receive a paper form in the mail. If still haven't responded by April 27th, you'll receive notice that a census worker will visit to help you fill out the form.
- The 2020 Census consists of nine questions about the people who live in your house, including sex, age, race, and ethnicity. You will NOT be asked about your income, financial information or Social Security number. You will also NOT be asked if you are a citizen.
- College students living in dorms, people in nursing homes, and those who are incarcerated on April 1, 2020 will be counted in those places and should not be included in your household count.
- Federal law states that data collected by the census is confidential and will remain anonymous. Census data cannot be used against any person by any government agency or court. All census workers take an oath of non-disclosure that protects your confidential answers.
- Beware of SCAMS! The U.S. Census Bureau will never ask for your social security number, money, donations, or bank and credit card numbers. The U.S. Census Bureau will never send an invitation to complete the census via email.

ReadyChesCo

ReadyChesCo is used to notify you during a major crisis or emergency, and delivers important emergency alerts; such as weather, road closures, health, or community alerts. You can choose to sign up by county, municipality, or by topic.

Notifications and updates can be delivered to you on all your devices: email account (work, home, other), cell phone (via SMS), pager.

Registration takes only a few minutes! You can register by visiting readychesco.org or call Abbey at 610-384-0600 x148 for assistance.

It is free to sign up for ReadyChesCo, and you can choose the type of alerts that you get. Your wireless carrier may charge you to get messages on your device, so check your plan to see what is covered. You can choose to stop getting these messages at any time.
