## **Tennis Court Improvements**

This summer, Public Works crews will be performing badly-needed updates on the tennis courts in Caln Municipal Park. In June, the old posts and nets will be replaced and the courts will be closed for a couple of days to allow the new concrete to set. Then, the week of August 21, the courts will be completely resurfaced. The new color scheme (also used by the U.S. Open) maximizes visibility and reflects more sunlight, making for a cooler, more environmentally-friendly courts. We'll also be adding contrasting lines for pickle ball! Signs will be posted to alert park users when the courts are closed.
