SUMP PUMP AMNESTY PROGRAM

There is still time to take advantage of the Municipal Authority's Sump Pump Amnesty Program. The Amnesty Program period will last until May 31, 2019. Property owners should inspect their own plumbing, in order to identify illegal sump pump, floor drain, or downspout hookups and to remove any illegal connections. Not sure if your connections are legal? Call 610-384-0600 ext. 139 for assistance. It is important that any property owner that identifies an illegal connection call to schedule an initial inspection to verify the connection, and to implement its disconnection.
