

Leaf Vacuuming

The week of December 3rd will be your last chance to participate in the Township's leaf-vacuuming program. Please be sure that leaves are piled at the curb by December 3rd. Leaves must be as close to the road's edge as possible and not obstructed by vehicles. Please DO NOT rake leaves into the street as leaves could get washed into storm inlets during inclement weather or can freeze to the roadway.
