DEVELOPMENT Update

• 50 Rock Raymond Rd. (Taco Bell) - approved for development, finalizing legal agreements, request for extension of zoning variance approval, ZHB approved extension. Resubmission received and in review.

• Behrle/The Villages at Hillview - preliminary plan on agenda for approval at Oct. 10 BOC meeting.

• Chester County School Authority Horticultural building – site work in progress, building plans approved.

• Christian Faith Fellowship - motion for approval of preliminary plan approval being prepared for the BOC.

• Hills at Thorndale Woods - final PRD plan resubmission in review.

• Wild Meadows – Board of Commissioners approved scheduling a hearing for the matter, no date set yet.

• 2131 Lincoln Highway – Zoning change to allow self storage, BOC hearing scheduled October 10 at 7:00 PM

• 2825 Lincoln Highway, Paoli Enterprises, conditional use hearing scheduled for Oct. 10 BOC meeting.

Leaf Vacuuming Program

Leaf vacuuming will begin the week of October 28. Rather than bagging your leaves, you need only rake them to the front of your property, immediately adjacent to the road's edge. Leaves must be as close to the road's edge as possible and not obstructed by vehicles. Please DO NOT rake leaves into the street as leaves could get washed into storm inlets during inclement weather or can freeze to the roadway as we get cooler temperatures.

Below is the schedule for this season's leaf pickup:

Township leaf vacuuming begins "week" of the following dates:

- Week of October 28th and week of November 11th for Monday and Tuesday trash customers
- Week of November 4th and week of November 18th for Wednesday and Thursday trash customers
- Week of November 23rd and week of December 2nd (Township-wide clean up)

TOWNSHIP CODE: FIRES

As the days get cooler, please be aware of the following laws about fires in the township:

- Burning municipal waste, leaf and yard waste, as well as recyclable material is unlawful.
- Recreational fires are permissible, without a permit, subject to the following guidelines:
 - Size is limited to 2 feet wide, 2 feet long and 2 feet in height
 - Must be a minimum of 50 feet from a structure or combustible material
 - Must be constantly attended and have a means of extinguishment; pressurized water extinguisher, garden hose or a bucket of loose dirt/sand
- Larger bonfires are permissible by permit only. Please contact codes@calntownship.org or 610-384-0600 x2
