## A RESOLUTION APPOINTING PASTOR MARK MOORE AS SENIOR CHAPLAIN FOR THE CALN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS**, Police Chaplains serve an integral role in providing comfort to members of the Police Department as well as the public and aid in community policing; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Caln Township Commissioners as follows:

- 1. **QUALIFICATIONS**. Any person appointed as Senior Chaplain shall be an ordained/licensed/certified clergyperson in good standing in the religious body from which he/she is selected. The Chaplain shall have basic training, and shall be a certified Police Chaplain.
- 2. DUTIES OF SENIOR POLICE CHAPLAIN. In addition to the duties of Chaplain, serve as liaison agent between the Police Department and Department Chaplains; serve as a member of the review panel during the Chaplain selection process; facilitate initial and refresher Chaplaincy training; serve as advisor to the Chief of Police on matters of theology/spiritual guidance; advocate for the Chaplaincy Program and Chaplain development.
- 3. **RANK AND SALARY**. Any person appointed as Chaplain shall serve in that capacity without Rank or Salary.
- 4. **TERM OF OFFICE**. A person appointed as Senior Chaplain shall serve for a period of one (1) year from date of appointment and shall continue to serve in that capacity until he/she is either terminated or resigns with the recommendation of the Chief of Police.
- 5. APPOINTMENT. The Chief of Police may appoint persons that he/she believes meet the qualifications of the CTPD with reference to Chaplains, if any. All applicants for the position of Senior/Chaplain shall be reviewed by the Chief of Police to determine his/her qualifications to serve in such a capacity. The Chief of Police shall appoint Chaplains in accordance with Ordinance 2016-06 and with the advice and consent of the Township Commissioners.
