A RESOLUTION OF CALN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPOINTING TRACEY LAWS AS THE RIGHT TO KNOW OFFICER FOR CALN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, Caln Township is a political subdivision of Pennsylvania and is subject to the rules and procedure established by the Pennsylvania Right to Know Law and the Office Open Records, and

WHEREAS, the Office of Open Records requires that an individual at each local agency is appointed to be the primary contact for all Right to Know requests from the public, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wishes to appoint Tracey Laws as the Police Department Right to Know Officer to fulfill all duties as legally specified by the Office of Open Records, and it is recognized that there is no additional compensation for this position and all duties associated with this position will be conducted in addition to her role as Police Administrative Assistant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT CALN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPOINTS TRACEY LAWS AS THE POLICE DEPARTMENT RIGHT TO KNOW OFFICER FOR CALN TOWNSHIP.
