CALN TOWNSHIP CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA RESOLUTION 2024-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CALN TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR A MUNICIPAL RECYCLING PROGRAM GRANT UNDER SECTION 902 OF THE MUNICIPAL WASTE PLANNING, RECYCLING AND WASTE REDUCTION ACT (ACT 101 OF 1988).

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection is accepting grant applications for funds authorized under Section 902 of the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act (Act 101 of 1988), and allocated from the Recycling Fund authorized under Act 101, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Caln Township, Chester County Pennsylvania (the "Board") is interested in submitting a grant application for the purchase of a Chipped Materials Truck at a cost of \$148,210.00, to assist in increasing the cost-effectiveness of the chipping program as part of the Township's yard waste recycling program, and,

WHEREAS, the Board is interested in submitting a grant application for the purchase of 29065-gallon recycle carts at a cost of \$17,545.00 and the purchase of 49 95-gallon recycle carts at a cost of \$3,259.00, to assist in increasing collection of recyclables for new residential properties as part of the Township's single stream recycling program, and,

WHEREAS, as part of the required 10% match necessary for the grant, the Board intends to utilize the costs of the reimbursement of the Excess Budget amount associated with the purchase of the leaf truck and 3 hoses in 2023 as part of Grant Agreement # C9900003296 in the amount of \$20,633.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Caln Township, that the Township Manager is hereby authorized to forward the executed grant application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection requesting grant funds in the amount of \$170,682, which is equal to 90% of the total costs to be submitted under the application.
