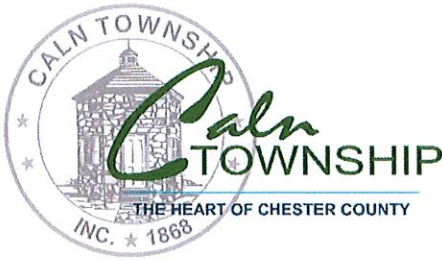

In compliance with Section 155-127 of the Zoning Ordinance and Section 5607 of the 2018 IFC, the application for a blasting permit is **APPROVED.**

- Operating hours are limited to 07:00 – 22:00 excluding Sundays and holidays (defined in Article XV of the Zoning Ordinance)
- Blasting is to be conducted Monday through Friday, 07:00 to dusk per contractor – typical actual blasting time will be approximately 13:00
- No explosives are to be stored onsite, magazines will be brought to site daily and removed at end of day
- Map of blasting area is attached, major deviations shall be submitted to Township and approved PRIOR to work
- Blasting occurring along developed areas shall have vibration and air blast precautions in place (5607.3, IFC 2018)
- Blasting area security shall be in place during all blasting days, including traffic control when near roadways
- A post blast procedure shall be in place and available for inspection

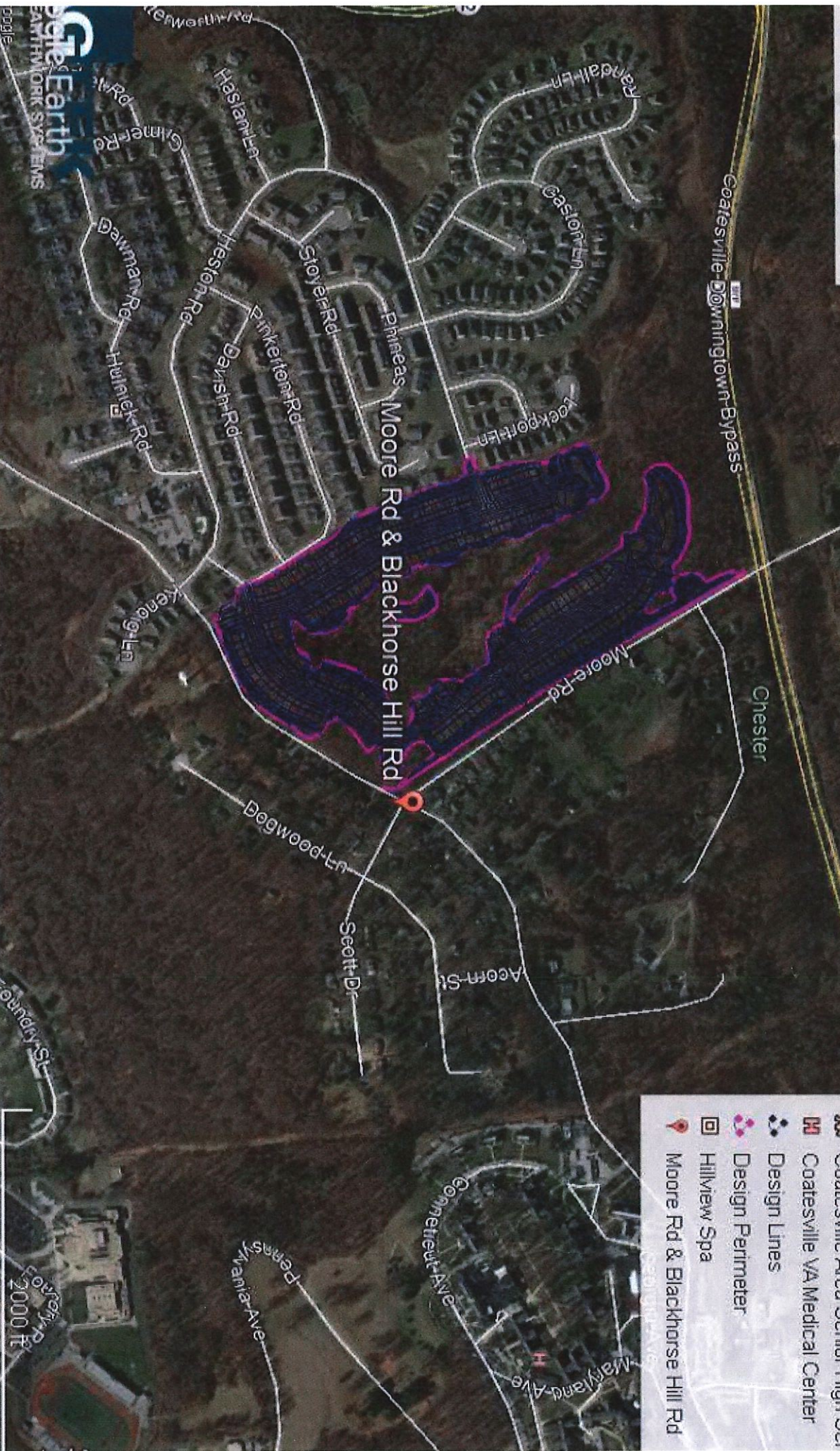
