All bids shall include but are not limited to all wages; payroll taxes; fringe benefits; overhead; cost for compliance with all state and federal regulations; field related costs; consumables; other taxes and profit. Please include a price per cut and an overall price for twenty-eight (28) cuts.

Caln Township will contact Lawn Maintenance services for the 2025 cutting season as needed, the areas to be mowed and trimmed:

1. Open space by Township - Meadow areas not to be mowed
2. Lloyd Park
3. Municipal Park
4. Dawkins Park
5. Caln Park West
6. Spackman Farmhouse Property
7. Deer Drive Park
8. Brookfield Basin
9. North Caln Road Pump Station
10. Portion of Township Sewer Right Away from Rt. 340 to Lloyd Ave,
11. G.O. Carlson Walkway Area
12. Area around Township Building and Public Works Garages
13. Kings Grant Pump Station
14. Route 340 and North Bailey Road Cell Tower
15. Streambanks are not to be mowed up to 8 feet.
16. No weed whacking around tree tubes

**Specifications:**

- It is the intent of Caln Township to provide a lawn maintenance program that will keep the sites in a state of perpetual growth and repair.
- The lawn maintenance shall include, but not limited to, mowing, trimming, edging, and cleanup.

**The following services will be required:**

1. Weekly mowing or as needed\*, grass to be cut to a height of 2 ½ inches,
  2. Trim around all obstacles on lawn areas with each mowing,
  3. Remove all grass clippings from walkways, parking lots, and other paved areas.
  4. General cleanup of trash and debris left on grass.
  5. Trim along all paved areas (including trails) monthly.
- The contractor will furnish all labor, supervision, equipment, fuel, materials, tools, supplies, services, and special skills required to perform the maintenance as set forth in these specifications.
  - The areas to be mowed on a regular interval at a height no lower than two and a half inches and not to exceed three inches between cuttings, using mower blades sharpened on a regular basis.
  - No more than one third (1/3) of the leaf blade is to be removed at one time.
  - Grass clippings are to remain on the lawn to decompose. Mulching mowers and blades are required, all care must be taken to prevent clumping of grass.
  - During cleanup, cut grass will not be blown onto any roadway or into any storm drain.
  - No mowing will be performed in wet conditions as to not damage the turf, drainage, or soil.
  - Every attempt will be made to prevent clumping of grass.
  - Every precaution will be utilized to avoid spilling or leaking petroleum products.

If such spillage/leakage does occur the Contractor will take immediate steps to clean up the spill in accordance with recommended standards for dealing with spillage of hazardous materials. Trimming around obstacles shall include, but not be limited to, all turf adjacent to:

- Services will be provided on a **weekly or as needed basis\***. The rate to be charged shall include time, equipment, and operators required to maintain the lawns, giving a neat and trim appearance.

**Caln Township reserves the right to not have lawn maintenance performed during drought conditions. Should these conditions occur, Caln Township will notify the Contractor by telephone, fax, or email at least 48 hours prior to the regular lawn maintenance day.**

Supervision and Labor. The Contractor shall provide a competent supervisor satisfactory to the Township authorized to act for the Contractor. The Contractor shall promptly remove from the work site any supervisor or employee whose work or conduct is not satisfactory to the Township. The Contractor shall enforce strict discipline and good order among the Contractor's employees. The Contractor shall exercise the necessary supervision and control to prevent Contractor's employees from violating any rules and regulations. The Township reserves the right to require the contractor to remove any employee that the Township deems unfit. The contractor must first get approval from the Township before any worker that has been removed from work returns to work.

- **Safety.** The successful Contractor agrees to adhere to and enforce all applicable local, state, federal, and OSHA safety regulations. Contractor shall provide safety barriers, as required, to clearly identify the working area and to prevent others from accessing the work area. This safety zone shall be sufficiently sized to prevent damage to others or existing facilities and structures. Upon completion of the work, Contractor shall remove the safety barriers from the work area.

- **Inspection**, an agent of the Township shall inspect work on a regular basis. And report any issues to the Contractor Foreman in writing.
- **Insurance Certificates:** Every bidder must supply certificates of insurance to the Township for:
  1. Worker's Compensation Insurance that complies with the workers' compensation laws of Pennsylvania.
  2. Automobile Liability Insurance with minimum of \$500,000 combined with single limit bodily injury and/or property damage.
  3. Comprehensive General Liability Insurance with minimum limits of \$500,000 combined single limit bodily injury and/or property damage.

- **Performance Bond:** The successful bidder shall furnish a bond guarantee in the performance of the contract, in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the amount of the contract, within twenty (20) days after the contract is awarded. If the bidder fails to furnish the bond within twenty (20) days, the contract is void and the township shall claim the amount in the bid bond as liquidated damages. Performance Bond amount will be based on 28 cuttings for the entire season.
- **Bid Bond:** Each bidder shall provide a bid bond, certified check, or cash in the amount of ten percent (10%). Bid bond will be based on 28 cuttings for the entire season.
- All Bids will be considered to be valid for a period of sixty (60) days from the opening date.
