ORDINANCE #2025-05

ADOPTING THE FINAL 2026 MUNICIPAL BUDGET

An Ordinance of the Township of Caln, in the County of Chester, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, appropriating specific sums estimated to be required for the specific purpose of the municipal government hereinafter set forth, during the year 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Caln, Chester County, Pennsylvania;

SECTION 1: that the expenditures and expenses as delineated in the year 2026 budget attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance, are hereby appropriated from the fund equities, revenues, and other financing sources available in the year 2026 as identified in the attached budget.

SECTION 2: that all funding sources, fees, assessments and taxes including the Annual Sewer Rental Fees, Local Services Tax, Earned Income Tax, Occupational Privilege Tax, Real Estate Taxes, Trash Collection and Recycling Collection Fees, Real Estate Transfer Taxes, Indebtedness Tax, Fire Tax, and EMS Tax are described in said budget and in the applicable Township Ordinances and fee schedules as adopted for the year 2026.

SECTION 3: that a copy of this ordinance shall be available for public inspection at the Municipal Building during normal business hours.

SECTION 4: that any ordinance or section thereof conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
