

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CALN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AWARDED A CONTRACT TO EAGLE DISPOSAL OF PA TO ACCEPT, PROCESS AND MARKET RECYCLABLE MATERIALS FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2019 AND TERMINATING DECEMBER 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Caln Township (the "Board") is responsible for the processing and marketing of recyclable materials collected as part of the Township's Curbside Municipal Waste and Recycling Collection Contract (the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania law does not require the Township to publicly bid a contract for the sale of recyclable material, 53 P.S. §4001.2; and

WHEREAS, Eagle Disposal of Pa, Inc. submitted a proposal to the Township dated October 9, 2018 offering to furnish all materials, equipment and labor to accept and market all Recyclable Materials (as that term is defined in the Contract) for a term of one year, beginning January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to accept the proposal and enter into the agreement with Eagle Disposal of Pa, Inc; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends to enter into the agreement with Eagle Disposal of Pa, Inc;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Caln Township that the President shall be authorized to execute the proposal from Eagle Disposal of PA dated October 19, 2018, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" for the acceptance, processing and marketing of Recyclable Materials for a term of one (1) year, beginning January 1, 2019 at a rate of \$25.00 per ton. The agreement shall be re-evaluated by each party in August of 2019 and shall automatically renew thereafter for successive terms of one (1) year each, unless either party gives written notice of termination to the other party by certified mail at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the then-existing term.
