A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CALN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ENDORSING AND ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BEAVER CREEK TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY OF 2019

WHEREAS, Caln Township in collaboration with the Brandywine Conservancy and Chester County Planning Commission conducted a study by members of a task force comprised of residents, township staff, and officials of the county and local government, and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study calls for a three-mile-long multi-use trail that will connect Caln Township and Thorndale Shopping District and the Borough of Downingtown, and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study took recommendations from Landscape III, the 2017 Caln Township Comprehensive Plan, and the Chester Valley West Trail Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CALN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ENDORSES AND ACCEPTS THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BEAVER CREEK TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY OF 2019.
