A RESOLUTION OF CALN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE
POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PAY FOR BODY CAMERAS FROM SURPLUS POLICE BUDGET 2021

A RESOLUTION authorizing the Police Department to pay the full amount for WatchGuard Body
Cameras in the amount of \$34,698 from surplus monies in the Police Budget of 2021, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners authorized the Police Department to purchase Body
Cameras for the Police Department in June of 2020, and

WHEREAS, the intent at that time is that the Cameras would be delivered in a timely manner, and

WHEREAS, due to national supply chain issues the cameras were not delivered in the timeframe
expected and several budget cycles had passed, and

WHEREAS, the Police Department due to vacancies ran a significant surplus in 2021 and would
like to amend the original intentions of the Board of Commissioners to pay for the equipment
over four (4) years and instead make one lump sum payment of \$34,698.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Caln Police Department is authorized to pay the full
amount for WatchGuard Body Cameras in the amount of \$34,698 from surplus monies in the
Police Budget of 2021.
