WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PENNDOT) wishes to share Commonwealth intellectual property in the form of video sharing with other public agencies who are integral to the safe operations of State Highways, and

WHEREAS, one of the agencies that has been identified in this process is local municipalities and their police departments, and

WHEREAS, to participate in this program PENNDOT requires a signed agreement for the use of Commonwealth Intellectual Property to access PENNDOT Intelligent Transportation Systems, and

WHEREAS, the elected officials of Caln Township see the value of participating in this program and appreciate sharing in vital transportation information with PENNDOT.
