RESOLUTION NO. 2022-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CALN TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH CHESTER COUNTY TO PROVIDE PROCESSING AND MARKETING OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, Act 1996-177, hereinafter the "Act", permits local governments to jointly cooperate and enter into joint agreements in the performance of their respective governmental functions, powers, or responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority in Act 101 of July 28, 1998, known as the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act, Chester County awarded a bid for a contract for the process and marketing of recycling materials to Solid Waste Services, Inc., doing business as J.P. Mascaro and Sons, on August 17, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the County has offered to provide the process and marketing service for the recycling materials generated in Caln Township through the successful bidder; and

WHEREAS, Caln Township desires to enter the contract with the County and have the successful bidder provide the service for process and marketing of recycling materials;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOVLED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals.

The title and recitals to this Resolution as set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Authorization of Agreement.

The Board of Commissioners of Caln Township hereby authorizes the execution of the Intermunicipal Agreement Between the County of Chester and Caln Township to Provide Processing and Marketing of Services for Recyclable Materials ("Agreement"), attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3. Purposes and Objectives of the Agreement.

The purpose of the Agreement is to authorize the County's successful bidder, Solid Waste Services, Inc. doing business as J.P. Mascaro and Sons, to provide processing and marketing services for all recyclables generated in the Township.

Section 4. Term of Agreement.

The term of the Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2023 and shall remain in effect unless terminated for cause or by either party providing at least 90 days written notice to the other party.

Section 5. Financing of the Agreement.

Caln Township shall pay for the services pursuant to the contact awarded by the County on August 17, 2022.

Section 6. Designation of Authorized Signers.

Kristen Denne, Township Manager/Secretary and Paul Mullin, President of the Board of Commissioners shall have the authority to execute all documents and agreements between the Township and the County of Chester to facilitate processing and marketing of recyclable materials generated by Caln Township

Section 7. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective from the date of adoption.
