A RESOLUTION OF CALN TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, DESIGNATING THE 2025 EMERGENCY SERVICE
PROVIDERS FOR CALN TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Caln Township are responsible under the Caln Township Code for the public safety of the residents of Caln Township, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Chester has requested that Caln Township provide the Board of Commissioners with a resolution outlining the methods and agencies chosen to fulfill the public safety needs of Caln Township for the efficient administration of the integrated emergency communications system of the Chester County Department of Emergency Services, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Caln Township Department of Building and Life Safety and Thorndale Volunteer Fire Company will provide fire protection coverage for the entire Township, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Caln Township Department of Building and Life Safety and Thorndale Volunteer Fire Company will provide rescue service for the entire Township, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Minquas Fire Company – EMS Division will provide emergency medical service covering the entirety of Caln Township for both Advanced Life Support and Basic Life Support service, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Caln Township Police Department will provide police protection, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Building and Life Safety will assure for and oversee the operations of fire and emergency medical service delivery within the Township, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that Raymond Stackhouse is appointed as Emergency Coordinator, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township authorized contact person between service organizations and the Chester County Department of Emergency Services shall be the Caln Township Director of Building and Life Safety, the duly designated Fire Chief of the Thorndale Volunteer Fire Company, and the Caln Township Chief of Police.
